Construction in 3 stages

Stage 1

New HOV lane westbound and direct-access ramps between Mercer Island and Bellevue.

Completed 2008

Stage 2

New HOV lane eastbound, direct access ramps between Bellevue and Mercer Island **Complete: early 2012**

Stage 3

New HOV lanes both directions, Seattle-Mercer Island; tunnel fire-safety upgrade.

Construction: August 2014 Complete: September 2016










I-90 Homer M. Hadley Bridge at completion of East Link
