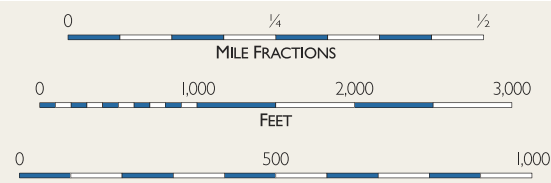
Park on the Lid
