

## SPILL RESPONSE PROCEDURE

## **CONTROL & REPORT**

- Identify spilled material. Is the source discernible? Accessible?
  Is there a fire hazard? In the event of a hazardous material spill,
  CALL 911 and secure the site to the best of your ability until
  emergency response crews arrive.
- 2. Secure the area: shut off source if possible, put on appropriate PPE, assist others.
- 3. Notify municipal staff: **206-275-7608** for CRT/ROW dispatch or **206-641-0466** for after hours/weekend.
- 4. Potential threat to human health, welfare, or environment? If YES, call Department of Ecology at **206–594-0000** ASAP (no more than 24 hours).
- 5. Apply spill kit equipment/control measures for cleanup of *non-hazardous* materials. Primary goal is to prevent spill from entering City's MS4 system (storm drains).
- 6. After spill is contained & cleaned up: dispose of contaminated materials appropriately. Dispose of toxic materials (such as fuel, motor oil, pesticides, construction/home-furnishing products, cleaners, detergents, and other chemicals or solvents) at

- 7. Follow-up: initial responder (you) or other designated City staff may need to educate responsible party of future corrective and/or preventative measures, replace or repair infrastructure in case of leak/cross-connection/etc, or support punitive action in case of deliberate discharge of illicit materials.
- 8. Restock your spill kit!
- 9. Retain all records (response actions, incident reports, public communications) in CityWorks.
