TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS:

The attention of all prospective bidders for the above referenced project is directed to the following clarifications and modifications to the Contract Documents. Bidders must acknowledge receipt of all addenda on the Bid Form.

ITEM NO. 1 – SPECIFICATION SECTION 09 94 14, STEEL WATER STORAGE TANK PAINTING

Part 1.6 H.1. notes lead test results from 2014. The attached lead test results are hereby added to the Contract Documents as a supplement to Specification Section 09 97 14

ITEM NO. 2 – MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

On page M&P-4, ADD the following paragraph to the description to Bid Item #9 – Reservoir Testing, Flushing, and Disinfection:

"Testing, Flushing, and Disinfection of the South Reservoir is a contingent item, and will only be completed as necessary based upon the means and methods for completing the work under other bid items and as agreed upon by the City. At least one of the two reservoirs shall remain in service at all times."

ITEM NO. 3 – SPECIFICATION SECTION 33 01 13.13, REHABILITATION OF STEEL ABOVEGROUND WATER UTILITY STORAGE TANKS

Page 33 01 13.13-3, ADD the following sentence to Part 3.1:

"The contractor shall sequence the work so that at least one of the two reservoirs shall remain in service at all times."

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

• Question 1: Are there places on site to hook up water for power washing?

Answer: There is a hydrant located to the west of the existing pump station which can be used for power washing

• Question 2: Will tanks be empty when work will be performed?

Answer: It is assumed that the North Reservoir will need to be removed from service for work associated with replacement of the vent. It is assumed that the work on the South Reservoir may be able to be completed with the tank in service if the Contractor provides the City with an acceptable plan for performing the work while maintaining water quality.

• Question 3: If drainage of tanks is needed will the Owner be responsible for the cost of water?

Answer: The City will not charge the Contractor for water used for cleaning and refilling a reservoir.

• Question 4: Will the owner provide a copy of AWWA C652?

Answer: Due to licensing restrictions, the Owner cannot provide a copy of AWWA C652.

Question 5: Do the existing coatings on either tank contain lead?

Answer: See Addendum 1, Item No. 1.

• Question 6: The bid schedule states to price disinfection for (2), however the defined scope for the South Reservoir does not require entry. Does the City intend to drain both tanks?

Answer: See Addendum 1, Item No. 2 and the response to Question 2.
