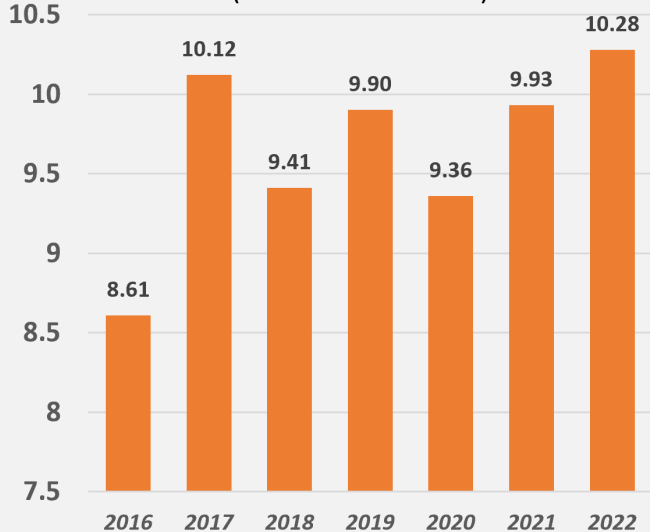


Total Natural Gas Usage

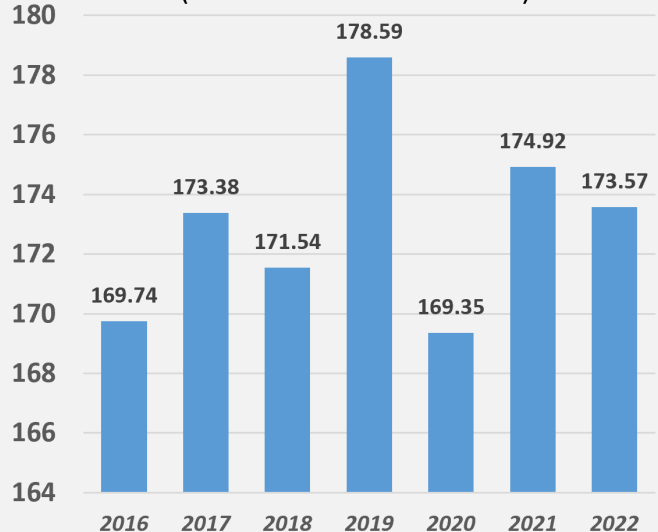
(millions of Therms)



Customer count rose from 6940 (2016) to 7155 (2022)

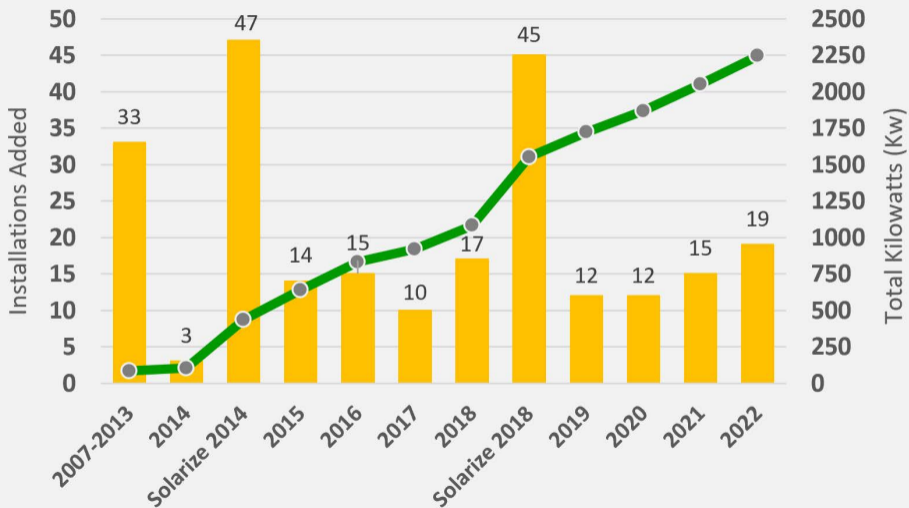
Total Electricity Usage

(millions of Kilowatt-hours)



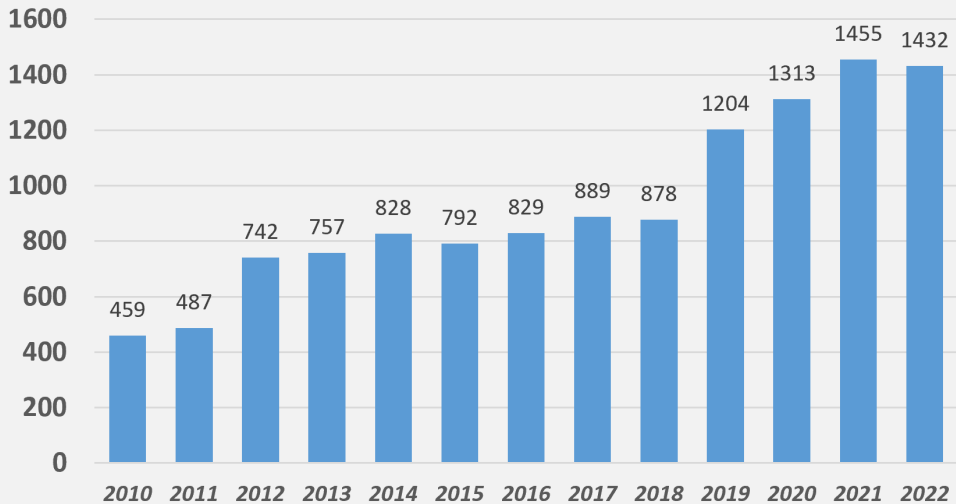
Customers rose from 10655 (2016) to 10746 (2022)

The City ran *Solarize* campaigns in 2014 & 2018 to promote and facilitate rooftop solar

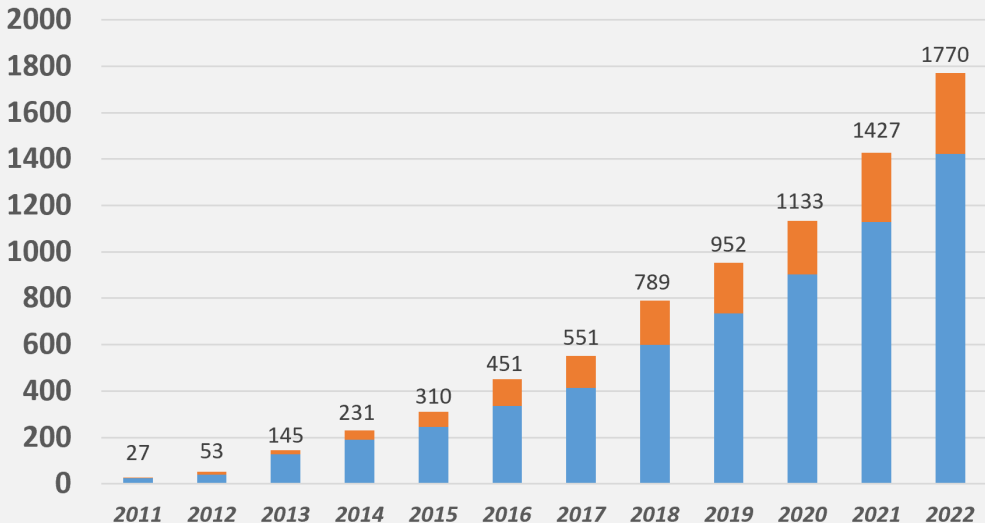
Total Accounts Purchasing Green Power

Total EV Registrations (New and Renewal)

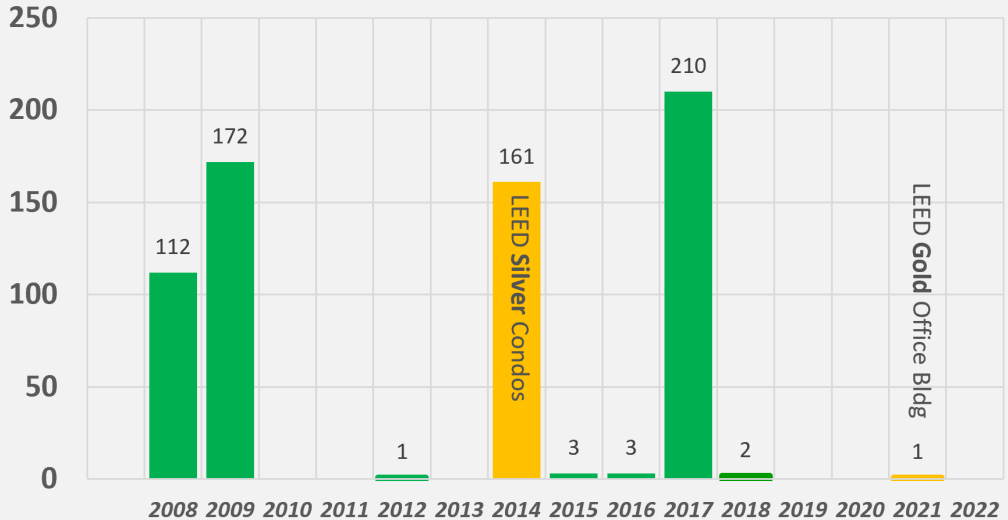
■ Battery EV ■ Plug-In Hybrid EV

Certified Green Units Built Each Year

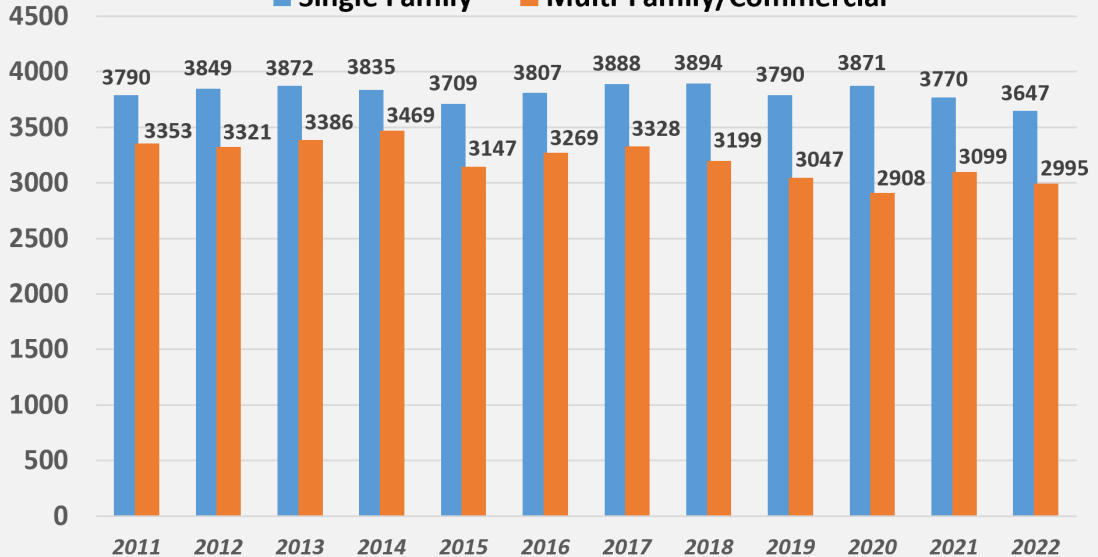
Built Green ■ LEED ■



As of 2016 all new Town Center buildings must be at least Built Green 4-Star or LEED Gold

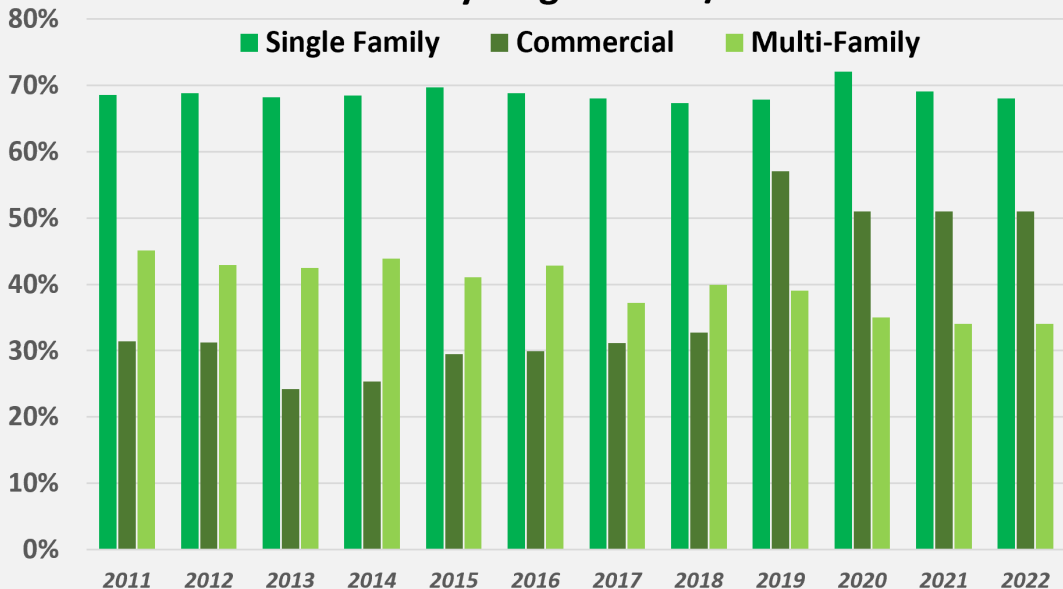
Landfill Waste by Sector (Tons)
