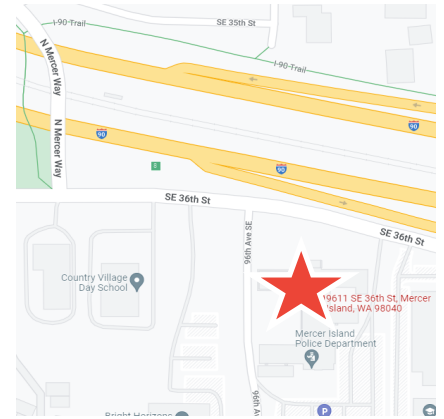

COMPOST BIN SALE

The City is offering compost bins for \$25 (cash only) while supplies last. Start backyard composting with a compost bin to save resources and money!



Composting turns yard waste into rich soil. Yard waste contains mostly water. Once the material decomposes, rich soil is all that's left. No pre or post event sales.

RAIN BARREL SALE

To encourage the use of recycled plastic material and more efficient use of water, the City is offering recycled plastic rain barrels at a big discount.

A limited supply of rain barrels will be available for \$25 (cash only) during the recycling event, while supplies last. One barrel per person. No pre or post event sales.
