1	I see the first step in the evaluation process is to review the "Preliminary Evaluation Minimum Qualifications," however, no submittal is requested for this step. Are contractors required to provide evidence for these qualifications (e.g. provide a copy of our registration, UBI, workers comp, etc.) or will the City be performing this review themselves via the State contracting website?	These requirements are met by the completion of the following:  1. Certificate of Non-Debarment 2. Certification of Compliance with Wage Payment Statutes Submittal 3. Contractor Declaration 4. Bidder's Qualification Certificate  No additional submittal is required.
2	In addition to the bid form, I see there are six additional forms to be submitted.  Should these forms be sent with our Phase 1 proposal, our Phase 2 proposal, or as a separate attachment entirely?	"Bidder's Checklist" has 6 documents required:  1. Non-Collusion Declaration (Phase 1 proposal)  2. Bid Form (Phase 2 Proposal)  3. Contractor Declaration (Phase 1 proposal)  4. Bid guaranty Bond (Phase 1 proposal)  5. Instruction to Bidders (Phase 1 proposal)

	The below "Contract Documents and Other Supplemental Forms" are provided for awareness and will be required from the bidders who are awarded contracts per the "Bidders Checklist", but are not required to be included in the bid submittal.  6. Public Works Contract, 7. Performance Bond, 8. Payment Bond, 9. Certificate of Insurance, 10. Retainage Agreement, 11. Statement of Intent to Pay Prevailing Wages, 12. Other documents requested by City.
