## 2022 Arterial and Residential Street Construction

## Dear Island Resident:

The City of Mercer Island will be repaving several roadways in two Mercer Island neighborhoods (map on the back) this summer. This work is following behind some water and storm drainage utility improvements that are currently underway. You are receiving this letter because your property has frontage on these roadways, access to your home is from one of these roadways, or construction activities may affect access to your home.

Asphalt resurfacing is planned for the following locations:

- Arterial: SE 68th Street and SE 70th Place, from Island Crest Way to East Mercer Way
- Residential: SE 65<sup>th</sup>, SE 66<sup>th</sup>, and SE 67<sup>th</sup> Streets, 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, and 83<sup>rd</sup> Place, in the plat of Parkwest
- Residential: 93<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and SE 68<sup>th</sup> Street, lying below SE 70<sup>th</sup> Place.

Work scope for the residential street resurfacing includes removing large, full width areas of pavement, regrading areas of gravel base, and repaving the roads with hot mix asphalt. For the SE 68<sup>th</sup> and SE 70<sup>th</sup> arterial, the scope of work includes pavement repairs, preleveling to correct settlement areas, and repaving of the roadway and adjacent uphill shoulder with a hot mix asphalt overlay. After repaving, shoulder areas will be dressed with crushed rock to meet new pavement edges, disturbed landscaped areas be restored with topsoil, seeding, and/or mulch, and utility castings (sewer manholes, water valves, catch basins) on the roadways will be adjusted to new pavement grade.

Resurfacing work is planned to occur in July and August, with the SE 68<sup>th</sup>, SE 70<sup>th</sup>, and 93<sup>rd</sup> Avenue areas occurring first. Paving work in Parkwest will occur after the utility work in that area is completed. The contractor will post temporary "No Parking" signage several days in advance of their work. During construction, please expect some minor delays and limited access to driveways at times. Flaggers may direct you around the block to avoid some construction activities. On paving days, one side of the roadway will be paved at a time. Vehicles will need to be clear of the street and shoulders when the contractor is working. Hours of work will typically be between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. No work on weekends is anticipated.


